

Thank you for your interest in my campaign.



First, thank you to the folks who voted for me. I appreciate your confidence in me and I will work hard to maintain that confidence. Thanks also to Director Merideth who reached out and wished me "good luck". I'd also like to thank the many folks who emailed and texted me congratulations. Unfortunately, I was not able to respond to each one individually. I'm sure I'll see most of you during the summer race season.

Second, I was pleasantly surprised when I reviewed the voting data on the <u>SCCA website</u>. Our area had more people vote (609) than any other divisional race. This was 30% greater than the next highest vote total which was in Area 3 (SEDiv) at 470. It shows you

Verne Wandell made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Dave Ferris, approved at 8:13 pm.


#### E Mail Votes Between Meetings:
