





2018 WMR Service Award Program

The WMR Board established a program for 2016 to recognize the efforts of our members who have assumed responsibility for and participated in the duties necessary to plan and support our regions events and activities. Points were awarded to members using a system which attempts to reflect the time and responsibilities involved. The first season's points recipients were awarded with dollar credits to be applied to their membership renewal, the purchase of SCCA merchandise or the WMR annual banquet.

The program has been approved by the board to be continued for the 2018 year with some enhancement and additional incentives. Bonus points will be awarded for members who are first time workers. There will also be bonus points for an increase in earned point totals over the previous year. We have added these bonuses to recognize those who participate for the first time to support our events as well as those who increase the days worked or assume additional responsibility.

2018 Runoffs Race Videos Now at SCCA.com

TOPEKA, Kan. (Nov. 2, 2018) -- It was a fantastic three days of competition Oct. 19-21 at Sonoma Raceway in California during the 2018 SCCA® National Championship Runoffs®. For those who couldn't make it to the track or missed the live online broadcast of races, it's now possible to catch up on all the action with free 2018 Runoffs race videos available for viewing at SCCA.com. Later this year, certain 2018 Runoffs races will also air on CBS Sports Network.

With nearly 500 entries across 28 different car classes, this year's 24 events featured exciting competition, close racing throughout the fields, a handful of surprises and some great storylines. Video coverage, presented by Mazda, was again anchored by Greg Creamer with guests Ryan Myrehn (SportsCar365 writer), Tom O'Gorman (pro driver), Heyward Wagner (pit reporter), Andy Hollis and Larry MacLeod (SCCA Solo Nationals announcers) providing additional insight and commentary.



The SCCA National Championship Runoffs has evolved into what is now commonly agreed to be the pinnacle of American motorsports. In Memoriam

William R. Gaunt

December 5, 1929 ~ October 17, 2018

We are all saddened to here that Lorrie Gaunt-Wandell's father has recently passed away. Lorrie was our past Chief of Timing and Scoring and her husband, Verne Wandell, is our current Treasurer and served as a Race Chair for a great many of our Club Racing events.

William Richard Gaunt, 88 of Midland died Wednesday morning, October 17, 2018 at his home. He was born December 5, 1929 in Detroit, the son of the late William and Vera (Elphick) Gaunt. He attended high school in Detroit and, after graduation, he went on to receive a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration from the University of Michigan's School of Business. Bill proudly served his country in the United States Army during the Korean Conflict. During the war, Bill took his place among the many US servicemen who founded, funded and served as mentors to the orphanages and orphans of Korea.

Bill was a kind, generous, thoughtful and loving person who continued his service to the community when he returned from the war. He served for over 50 years in various capacities at the Arnold Center; as a board member, on the financial committee, as their treasurer and was a member of their Emeritus Board into 2018. Bill also volunteered his time with "Lunch Box Learners", a Midland County partnership between the school and business communities formed to foster learning and increased self-confidence through reading in first through third grade students.

Bill was employed by Dow Corning as an auditor until his retirement after forty years of service. He married Lois Entenmann-Gaunt in 1982 and she preceded him in death on April 14, 2015. Together they had many happy years and enjoyed traveling the world. In his younger years he enjoyed handball. Bill was always voracious reader, appreciating all subjects but especially science fiction. He was also an avid bird watcher who delighted in looking for all species, especially his favorite the elusive snowy owl.

Bill is survived by his children Debbie Gaunt of Gladwin, Lorrie (Verne) Wandell of Kalamazoo, and Amy Gaunt (Tim Hill) of Woodridge, IL; stepchildren Brad (Nanette) Entenmann of Midland and Blair (Nancy) Entenmann of Rockford; grandchildren Michelle (Derek) Entenmann-Krupp of St. Louis, Claire Entenmann of Midland and Alexandra Hill of Woodridge, IL; and one great-grandson Greyson Krupp. In addition to his parents and wife, Bill was preceded in death by a step-daughter Pamela Entenmann.

Funeral services for Bill took place at 11:00 a.m. Saturday October 27, 2018 at the Ware-Smith-Woolever Funeral Home, 1200 W. Wheeler Street. Pastor John Pohanka officiated.
